



## Consent Form Go Laser Therapy

### *What to expect with Laser treatment for nail fungus:*

Pre-treatment photos will be taken.

All nail polish must be completely removed.

The nails will be debrided with a Dremel to thin the nail surface.

Laser-safety eyewear is required during the treatment.

The patient will be asked to report when they feel heat or discomfort.

All toes will be treated, unless there is a dark spot from blood or bleeding under the nail.

Patient will need to use a topical antifungal daily.

Shoe cleaning is required; Steri-Shoe or Antifungal spray is recommended.

Clean socks must be worn daily. Bleached white socks are preferred.

Tub and shower needs to be cleaned with bleach.

Apply fresh linens on your bed following first treatment with the Laser.

The Laser will kill the fungus; the new nail growth will be fungus free. It typically takes 9 months for the new nails to be fully grown out.

A series of 3 treatments, 6-8 weeks apart is considered a full treatment. Photos are taken after each session.
